Each scholarship recipient will need to attend a minimum of 22 days of face to face training and complete other self-paced coursework and assessments as directed outside of these deliver days.
All scholarship participants must complete all sections of the application form AND all supporting documents including evidence of accredited qualification/training and provide a satisfactory Police Check and Working with Children Check in order to be considered eligible for this scholarship.
Employment as an accredited shearing trainer will require a person to hold or become qualified with a Certificate III in shearing.
