Division Overview

The School of Education is responsible for the delivery of Victorian Pathway Certificate and the VCE Vocational Major, Disability Programs, English as an Alternative Language, Education Support, Sport & Recreation, Early Childhood Education and Care, Professional Education, across the Institute's campuses. The School has staff based at Warrnambool, Portland, Hamilton and Colac but may conduct programs in other regions.

The School supports the delivery of teaching and learning programs at SWTAFE, including the development and implementation of educational projects aligned with the strategic direction of the organisation in collaboration with our Industry and community partners. This will be achieved through the delivery of high-quality skills training that meet the current and emerging needs of the region.

Position Overview (Your Opportunity)

The VCE area delivers the Victorian Pathway Certificate and the VCE Vocational Major. The teaching teams work together to share ideas and resources to produce a high standard of delivery across all our programs and campuses. The teaching team also works in collaboration with SWTAFE Support Services.

TAFE teachers are accountable for the delivery of quality education, training and fee for service programs in accordance with the vocational education and training standards detailed in the Australian Quality Training Framework (AQTF) 2007. This position encompasses all facets of the learning process from course enquiry and advice to assessing and determining the training requirements of SWTAFE clients, The work requires the management of the

learning process for students using a variety of TAFE teaching strategies such as recognition of prior learning, on-line learning support, workplace learning, delivery and assessment as well as traditional classroom delivery.

This position provides high-quality training services on behalf of the VCE Programs area. The role requires an innovator who can effectively respond to the training demands of SWTAFE clients, who is able to work in a variety of environments and with different teaching and learning modes. The Teacher is also responsible for developing resources and assessment tools to support this delivery and for developing and maintaining relationships with industry and key government bodies.

TAFE teachers are expected to work effectively as members of a team and to be involved in a range of course and program coordination activities which support the effective operation of the teaching centre and the achievement of learning outcomes for students. To effectively support the department, this position may be required to coordinate and teach in other programs delivered by the department, including fee for service and industry based training. Any additional teaching requirements will depend on qualifications and expertise.
