Division Overview

The Warrnambool Tech School is a State Government key initiative in establishing Victoria as the Education State, where all Victorians can access high-quality education and training, regardless of their background, circumstances or postcode. As a centre of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) excellence, the Warrnambool Tech School will engage students from 26 partner schools in a high-tech learning environment that connects schools and industry in contemporary learning programs that challenge students to solve problems in a real-world context.

Programs focus on preparing students for a changing world, strengthening employability skills and linking the focus of secondary education to growing industries within the region as well as giving students a taste of higher education and potential career pathways.

Position Overview (Your Opportunity)

This position will lead and manage the development of project based and leading-edge STEM programs delivered by the Warrnambool Tech School to be accessed by secondary schools in the region. This will require the incumbent to engage with industry, partner schools and key stakeholders to create and deliver innovative technology rich learning programs with high levels of support for integration into classrooms and in building STEM capabilities within partner schools.



Position Description

The incumbent is a key member of the leadership team, supporting the Director to implement the strategic plan to realise the vision of the Warrnambool Tech School. They will be required to drive innovative program development, manage staff, and assist in generating business growth.

Partnering with the Director, the Head of Programs contributes to the overall strategic vision and direction of the Warrnambool Tech School and ensures the delivery of these strategic priorities.

The Head of Programs is responsible for overseeing all current program models ensuring they remain contemporary and relevant for all partner schools.

The Head of Programs is responsible in leading the Warrnambool Tech School Teacher Professional Development Programs providing opportunities for partner school teachers to build confidence and develop skills in using emerging technologies within an applied learning setting.

The Head of Programs is also responsible for driving the development of new leading-edge STEM programs aligned to the Victorian Curriculum. The position will influence the development of new programs aligned with the emerging trends in Education, Industry and the local community.

The Head of Programs will drive the integration of existing and emerging technologies across all program models.

Key Accountabilities

 innovative learning programs using emerging technologies linked to local industries
- In collaboration with the Director, ensure the Warrnambool Tech School has a vibrant and dynamic offering aligned to the needs of industry, community and school-based partners.
- Drive the integration of Tech School programs delivered on-site and off-site into partner school's curriculum.
- Investigate, develop and manage STEM and technology related professional development for teachers from partner schools, SWTAFE and other key stakeholders.
- In collaboration with the Director, maintain strategic relationships, alliances and partnerships with key stakeholders to promote the vision and goals of the Warrnambool Tech School. This includes engaging with partner schools, STEM and technology networks, industry and community partners.
- Facilitate student and teacher STEM education programs and projects as needed. Inspire students' and strengthen their connection to learning by engaging them in holistic projects, using emerging technologies and applying skills and knowledge in collaboration with others. Model expert facilitation as well as providing coaching & mentoring.
- Oversee the development of new programs, including micro-credentialing courses in line with the strategic vision of the tech school.
- Manage the implementation of programs and courses into the online portal and learning management system.
- Stay abreast of emerging trends in education, industry and technology to help inform the ongoing development of programs.
- In collaboration with the Director, lead the planning, development, implementation and review of Warrnambool Tech School programs in line with organisational policies and procedures.
- Ensure all existing and new programs meet OHS & WHS requirements.
- In collaboration with the Director, contribute to the annual equipment funds application process required for new and existing programs, ensuring it aligns to the to the strategic vision of the tech school.
- In collaboration with the Director, coordinate the scheduling of programs annually and oversee the development of the annual program guide, ensuring it is accessible to all partner schools.
- Manage the development of the online portal, website, Learning Management System (LMS) and Customer Relationship Management (CRM).
- In collaboration with the Director, lead the planning, development, implementation and ongoing review of the Tech School operational policies and procedures.
- Ensure all are accountable for respect, equality and inclusion for student and employee experiences.

- A deep understanding of the Victorian Curriculum and Applied Learning Principles.
- Highly developed communication and interpersonal skills. With experience and demonstrated ability to inspire, lead and mentor staff/facilitators.
- Ability to engage and build strong collaborative relationships with a range of key stakeholders
- Experience in influencing key stakeholders to overcome challenges and ensure positive progress.
- Expertise in using a range of emerging technologies and a high level of understanding in STEM practices
 with demonstrated skill in using technologies to achieve outcomes within applied learning in educational
 settings.
- Demonstrated ability to manage competing priorities and achieve deadlines.
- Ability to research and analyse data, write reports and conduct presentations to inform key stakeholders
 across a broad range of audiences as well as the preparation of sound advice that will influence, policy and
 procedures on matters affecting the Tech School.
- Ability to demonstrate SWTAFE's values and behaviours.
